## **Documents to transfer to Devon Heritage Centre**

The following 10 boxes of items have been stored within the library for a number of years. The upcoming library relocation means we no longer have space to store these items, or in many cases the correct conditions to ensure the items are preserved for the future. This is particularly true for the photographs, early paper documents and engravings and wax seals.
