

Trusting in God - There is always hope

Looking around at the riots breaking out in different towns this summer we can feel fearful. It squashes us, our communities feel hemmed in and we feel a bit smaller, a bit more insecure, perhaps demoralised and frustrated. Maybe we're even moved to cry out to God in prayer, asking God - 'Why is it that bad people seem to be allowed to do bad things in this world'?

It's often genuinely confusing to try and make out where God is at work in His rebel human race. We can wrestle with it, chewing it over as we try and make sense of it all. Looking for hope, we try to perceive how any good could possibly come from these horrors...

In the bible, there's a wonderful verse at the end of Joseph's story in Genesis 50 where Joseph tells his brothers who'd sold him into slavery, "you intended it for evil, but God intended it for good". Joseph reframes the situation, and he turns his attitude from revenge to forgiveness and reconciliation. With discipline, perseverance and God's help, he recognises God's higher purpose that's in his suffering. Of course this is also what Jesus did, transforming the great injustice done to him into monumental, eternal, foundational, forgiveness and reconciliation. Jesus refers to his death by crucifixion and his resurrection when he says, "when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all people to myself". Bit by bit we catch a little glimpse of understanding, divinity at work, battle and blessing intertwined as the resurrection completes God's purposes for His life.

More recently, 56 years ago, Martin Luther King Jr., an American Minister and Civil Rights leader, made a speech the night before he was killed by an assassin's bullet: "We've got some difficult days ahead. But it really doesn't matter to me now because I've been to the mountaintop. I won't mind. Like anybody, I would like to live a long life ...but I'm not concerned about that now. I just want to do God's will. And he's allowed me to go up to the mountain. And I've looked over, and I've seen the promised land. I may not get there with you, but I want you to know tonight that we as a people will get to the promised land. So, I'm happy tonight. I'm not worried about anything. I'm not fearing any man. 'Mine eyes have seen the glory of the coming of the Lord'."

What an amazing calm in the face of hatred and violence! What an amazing sense of God's presence and conviction that God will work his purpose out, no matter what evil powers try to do.

In times of turmoil and unrest, our challenge is to look for an opportunity to reframe our own situation, to understand even just a little more of God's intention for good that might arise from some of the pain we're experiencing or witnessing. We've got to trust in God that as one door seems to close on us, there will be a window that is opening. We can be encouraged that as we follow Christ and trust Him for the journey, we will live our best lives, because he will be with us wherever we go. (Joshua 1:9)

Is someone you know 'print disabled'?

You, or someone you know, may struggle to read due to poor vision. But did you know that there are also other people who, for medical reasons, no longer find reading a pleasure? They may have a long-term condition such as Stroke, Parkinson's Disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Dyslexia or the early stages of Dementia, which can make reading difficult. Importantly, their medical condition, coupled with their print disability, can lead to a sense of loneliness and isolation.

The Mid Devon Messenger can help to keep people who are print disabled connected with their local community via weekly local audio news, information, entertainment ... and audio books – all free of charge!

A new listener recently wrote: "Thank you for ... making it possible for people like my brother to keep in touch with the outside world." Other listeners tell us they feel that the Messenger gives them a sense of being part of a community.

Jam and Jerusalem

Apple & Almond Cake.

This month is definitely Apple Time, and this year seems to be a very good year for them, whether this is down to a wet spring or not, I'm not sure, but let's enjoy what nature has given us.

Apart from the usual Apple Crumble, our favourite is Apple & Almond Cake, or you could class it as a sponge.

So start by making your usual Victoria Sandwich :-

4 ozs Caster Sugar

4 ozs Margarine (or I use Butter)

4 ozs SR Flour. (or you can add another oz if you like a denser cake)

2 eggs

A few drops of Almond essence.

3 med cooking apples sliced.

A few Flaked almonds for the top.



Beat Sugar and Marge together until fluffy, slowly add eggs with a little flour, then add the rest & the few drop of almond essence. Fold in the sliced apples and tip it all into a greased and bottom lined sponge tin. Sprinkle the flaked almonds on top and bake 25/30 mins 165 c.

Serve warm with custard & cream, or cold with a coffee, if there is any left! Sally
